

CAT 2023: Slot 3 Analysis

Points -

- The CAT 2023 Slot 3 paper was on par with the other two slots of CAT 2023.

- The CAT 2023 Slot 3 paper was tough with respect to all the slots of CAT 2022 question papers except for the VARC section.
- In the DILR section- 4 sets with 5 questions each (All from LR No DI Questions). Almost all sets were hard.
- Quants were very lengthy and were the toughest among all the 3 slots of 2022. Various experts have also stated it to be the toughest quant paper compared to the previous five-year paper. The level was moderate to hard.
- In Quants, the Maximum questions were from Arithmetic, followed by algebra, then modern math, geometry and numbers.
- In the RC section, 4 RCs with 4 questions each of variable difficulty.
- The VARC section was observed to be easier than Slot 1 and Slot 2.
- According to the student feedback, both the DILR and Quant sections seemed to pose a greater difficulty as compared to the previous two slots hence making the Slot 3 question paper the most challenging.

CAT 2023 Slot 3 Analysis

Introduction:

When we compare CAT 2023 Slot 3 to the previous years, we can understand that it followed the **same pattern** which was seen in the previous year, following the format that has become

familiar to aspirants. The examination consisted of **three sections—Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension (VARC), Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning (DILR), and Quantitative Aptitude (QA)**. There were a total of 66 questions, candidates were required to answer these within an allotted time of 120 minutes.

Difficulty level-

The CAT 2023 Slot 3 paper was tough with respect to the CAT 2022 paper.

The CAT 2023 Slot 3 paper was tough with respect to the CAT 2023 Slot 1 and Slot 2 papers.

Section-Wise Breakdown:

VARC (Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension):

Number of Questions: 24

Time Allotted: 40 minutes

Difficulty Level: Easy to Moderate

The VARC section consisted of 24 questions. The section began with the Reading Comprehension section which contained four passages with four questions each. Experts have suggested that the Reading Comprehension section of slot 3 was slightly easier when compared to the previous two slots. The Verbal Ability section followed the same format as previous slots where two Para jumbles, two Summaries, two Para Completion -and two Odd sentences were asked making a total of eight questions.

Remarks-

- RC1 was on Colonialism and Global Warming (The Nutmeg's Curse). The level of difficulty of this passage was 'Easy'.
- RC2 was on Understanding Romantic Aesthetics and this was also easy.
- RC3 was on Cultural Patrimony Laws and it was slightly more difficult compared to RC1 and RC2 hence it was of the 'Medium' level difficulty.
- RC4 was on Rationality by Steven Pinker and it was a 'Difficult' passage due to the usage of complex language and non-straight-forward questions.
- There was no mandatory question in slot 3 like that came in Slot 2.
- A candidate answering 10-11 questions with an accuracy of 75-80% can expect 99 percentile according to the existing trends.

DILR (Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning):

Number of Questions:
20 **Time Allotted:** 40
minutes **Difficulty**
Level: Moderate

The question pattern of the DILR section of CAT 2023 was observed to be following the same pattern as 2022. DILR had 20 questions clubbed into four sets of 5 questions each. According to experts, all four sets were do-able but were lengthy due to which the candidates may face time management problems. Answering two sets with an accuracy of 75-90% can help the students in achieving more than 90 percentile.

Remarks-

- The first set of questions was on the number of enrollments in Online and Offline courses. It was on the easy-to-medium scale.
- The second set of questions had moderate-level route-based questions on Police Stations.
- The third set of questions was on projects and scores of three boys and three girls. The difficulty level of this set was medium to difficult.
- The last set of questions was from 'AC company and Dealership'. It was the most difficult question set under DILR

QA (Quantitative Aptitude):

Number of Questions: 22

Time Allotted: 40 minutes

Difficulty Level: Difficult compared to slots 1 and 2

The QA section was the most challenging section for the candidates. The expert opinions conclude that the slot 3 quant paper was the most difficult paper in the last five years. Most of the questions were not straightforward and required number crunching. Questions from Time and Work as well as Time, Distance and Speed were also tricky. Most of the questions also required the application of multiple concepts to solve hence making it time-consuming. On the brighter side, 4-5 questions from arithmetic were observed to be doable. Answering 9-13 questions with 70-80% accuracy will be crucial for receiving more than 99 percentile in this section.

Remarks-

- The most number of questions were from the arithmetic section. A total of 8 questions were asked from this section which was a change from the previous slots.
- Four questions were asked from Algebra.
- Modern math included four questions in which 2-3 were doable.

- Three questions each came from geometry and numbers in which 4-6 were doable.

Marking Scheme:

For Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs), candidates were awarded +3 for correct answers and for incorrect answers -1 was deducted.

For non-MCQs(TITA), there was no negative marking for incorrect answers, and for each right answer, the candidate was awarded 3 marks.

Overall Difficulty Level:

The general trend among the candidates was that CAT 2023 Slot 3 concluded that it was the most difficult slot of all three. While the VARC section offered a bit more leniency, DILR was a touch more difficult than slot 2. The game changer was the quant section. While both the previous slots also had a challenging quant section, slot 3 was even more challenging making the overall slot the most difficult.
