CAT Syllabus for Reading Comprehension 2023

In the **Reading Comprehension** section, the candidates will be answering several MCQs. The candidates will have to read about 3 to 4 long comprehensions, along with 2-3 short ones. The length of the long passages will be around 900 words. The short passages will be around 600 words long. The topics will revolve around Politics, Literature, Science, History, Environment, Mythology, etc. In the VARC section, the Reading Comprehension section will occupy a weightage of about 70%.

- Reading Comprehension paragraphs will be around 900 words and shorter paragraphs will have about 600 words. Candidates will have to read the paragraph and answer the questions asked at the end.
- The CAT 2023 syllabus for current affairs includes the topics like the Current affairs of National and International importance, Impact of Covid 19 pandemic on social life, Government Policies, Immigration, New Education Policy, CAA, Triple Talaq, Make in India, Clean India.
- The CAT 2023 Syllabus for Economy includes topics like the Global Economic changes, Economic Development and Environment destruction, Demonetization, Unnecessary expenditure by the Government.
- The CAT 2023 Syllabus for Literature includes work from great philosophers like Aristotle, Charles Dickenson, Winston Churchill, Martin Luther King, Mohan Das Karam Chand Gandhi, and others.
- The CAT 2023 Syllabus for Science and Technology includes topics about the Modern world, the Advancement of Technology, and the fading of culture.
- The CAT 2023 Syllabus for History includes topics about the social changes in the History of India, War of Roses, French Revolution, Freedom Fights among others.
- The CAT 2023 Syllabus for Mythology includes topics about the important mythological, current social structure, and abstract fictional topics as well.

Quantitative Aptitude is a vital part of the CAT Maths syllabus. It has mainly questions from Arithmetic, Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus, Geometry. Questions in this section are given to test a candidate's ability to apply mathematical principles to solve real-time problems. Questions will be based on 10th and 12th Mathematics. The quant section of the CAT Syllabus previously had 32-34 questions weightage, but this year it is expected to be 22-24 questions only. The Quant syllabus is an important part of the CAT Maths Syllabus. The topics which have to be concentrated from the CAT 2023 Syllabus are provided below.

- Arithmetic- Number System, HCF, LCM, Ratio & Proportion, Simplification, Percentage, Average, Age Calculation, Time & Work, Distances, Profit, Loss, and Discount.
- CAT Algebra Syllabus- Hypothesis of Equations, Quadratic Equation, Permutation, and Combination, Sequence and Series, Linear Equation.
- Percentages- Percentages and its applications
- Trigonometry- Trigonometric Ratios, Heights, and Distances.
- Calculus- Minima and Maxima functions.
- Mensuration-Areas and Volumes Rectangles, Squares, Triangles, Circles, Cubes, Cones, Spheres, Pipes, and Cistern.
- Geometry and its applications- Angles, Lines, Triangles, Circles, Coordinate Geometry.
