IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- The National Law University Delhi will conduct the All India Law Entrance Test (2024) for admissions to the B.A.LL.B. (Hons.), LL.M., and Ph.D. Programs for the Academic Year 2024-25 (commencing in July 2024) on December 10, 2023, from 11:00 AM to 01:00 PM in Pen and Paper mode nationwide.
- The University has already issued the Admit Cards for the said test w.e.f. November 24, 2023. The registered candidate can download their Admit Cards from their AILET 2024 account till 11:59 pm on December 9, 2023.
- The candidates are not permitted to carry any communication devices like Cell Phone or any other Electronic Gadgets like Digital Watches, Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Pager, Health Band, Calculator etc. in the Examination Hall/Room. Analog watches may be allowed.
- Candidates are allowed to carry only the following items to the Examination Hall/ Room:
 - Blue/ Black Ball Point Pen
 - Admit Card
 - Any valid Photo I.D. Proof/ Adhaar Card/Recent School ID card etc.
 - Transparent Water Bottle
- Reach the Test Centre well in time before 1 hour to identify the Seating Place in the Seating Plan displayed and avoid crowding at a particular location at the Entrance Test Centre.
- Candidates are advised to bring their own BLUE/ BLACK BALL POINT PEN etc. and the sharing of Pen, Pencil etc. will not be allowed.
- **The instructions on the Question Booklet and on the OMR Response sheet are clearly visible to the candidate through the plastic cover. The candidates are required to read them before the commencement of the test at 11:00 AM. The candidates can only open the plastic packet exactly at 11:00 am.**
- At 1:00 pm, all the candidates shall stop writing and return the OMR Response Sheets to the invigilator. It may be noted that carrying the OMR Response Sheet out of the Test Centre will lead to disqualification of the candidate. It is an offence and appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.
